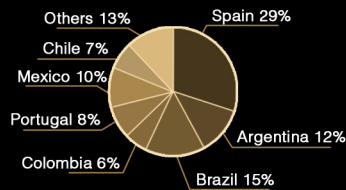

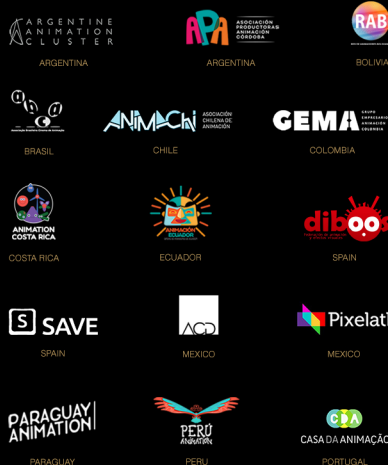

In 2023, the island generated an all-time record 103 million euros in audiovisual productions, of which the growing animation sector turned over 19 million euros in various projects such as the feature film SuperKlaus, the 5th season of Miraculous Ladybug, the Christmas special Merry Little Batman or Ghosts of Ruins.
